Policies 2020

- The Ballet Class Reserves the right to change classes/teachers at any given time due to changing circumstances.
- All parents/guardians must sign and return the registration/permission form before commencing classes with The Ballet Class
- No parents are allowed to watch classes, however, there are open days at the end of Term 1, Demonstration evening during Term 3 and the Annual performance Term 4.
- Parents should not engage in conversations with teacher between/during classes. Please remember other students have paid for tuition during this time. Parents should email the office if they have an urgent message.
- Teachers' mobile numbers are not given out to parents and students.
- No filming or photographing of The Ballet Class students is permitted at any time while in the care of The Ballet Class.
- Students are requested to wear The Ballet Class Tracksuit or suitable clothing to and from classes. Students should not be seen wearing their dance clothing in public streets.
- In the unfortunate circumstance that a teacher feels that an ambulance should be called for a student for any reason it will be the responsibility of the parents to pay the fees for this if their medical insurance does not provide ambulance cover.
- Students with outstanding fees from the previous term will not be accepted into the class until the fees are paid in full. Fees are not refundable and one term's notice is required if students wish to discontinue classes.
- Students are able to make up two classes during term time for missed classes.
- If a student's class falls on a public holiday the student is able to make up their class on any other day during the term.
- Term 4 fees are based on your fees that have been paid in previous terms throughout the year. No extra charges will be incurred if you are attending more classes than previous terms. If you chose to attend less classes in Term 4 your fees will not be reduced.
- Once a private lesson time is booked for the year it is the student's responsibility to attend their booked time from Term 1 to Term 3. If for some reason the student is unable to attend a lesson then it is the responsibility of the parent to find a suitable student to attend. The Ballet Class will assist with trying to find a replacement, however if one is not found payment of the said private lesson is the responsibility of the original booked student.
- All students representing The Ballet Class at Eisteddfods must wear The Ballet Class tracksuit to all events.
- All routines choreographed by The Ballet Class staff are the property of The Ballet Class and may not be performed in public without prior permission by the Principal of The Ballet Class. If permission is granted full accreditation must be given to the choreographer and The Ballet Class prior to the performance.
